## BANKRUPTCY AND REORGANIZATION

FOR THE SACRAMENTO TRADITIONAL JAZZ SOCIETY

The bottom line (*Here at the top*):

There <u>DEFINITELY IS</u> Sunday Jazz at the Riverside Elks in Sacramento Noon—5 PM February 11, 2018.

The Sacramento Traditional Jazz Society (STJS) has filed for Chapter 7, not Chapter 11 Bankruptcy. This means that the STJS is dissolved as a corporation. It is bankrupt and cannot continue.

A new organization is forming—-it cannot use the name Sacramento Traditional Jazz Society. It will have a new name. Elections will be held later to fill Executive and Board Offices.
