

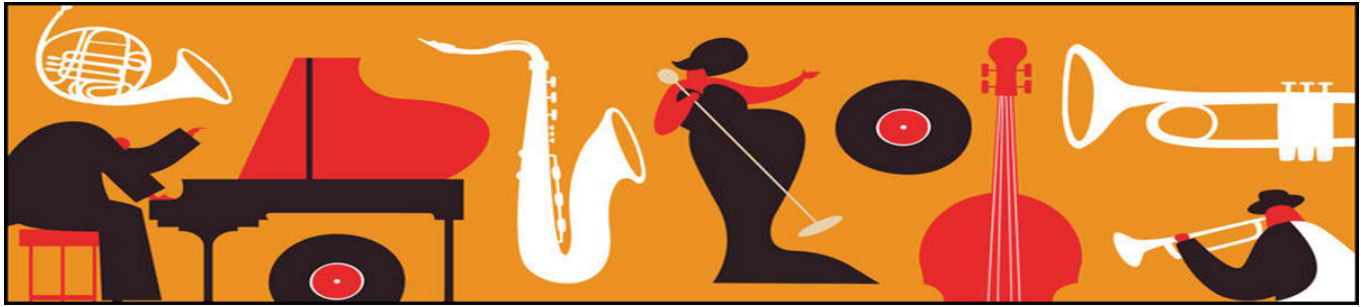

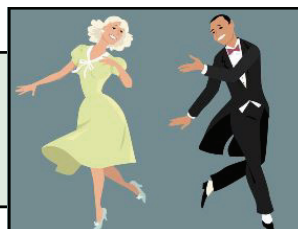
We will see all of you on Sunday, November 3, 2019 at the Stockton Elks Club.
