Income: \$509. (Door 320; Membership 50; Raffle/Misc 139.)

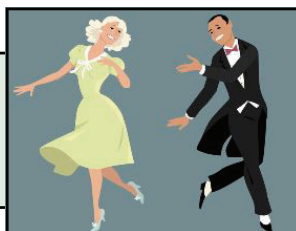
Expenses: \$351. (Rent 325; Office sup 26.)
