

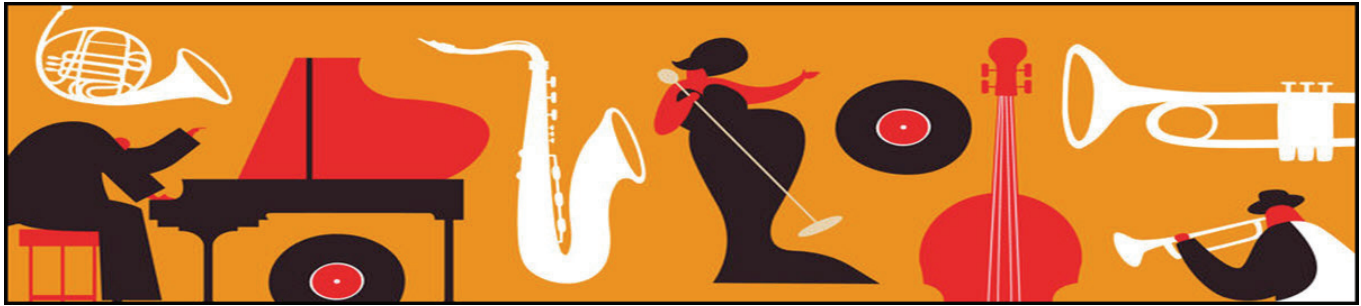

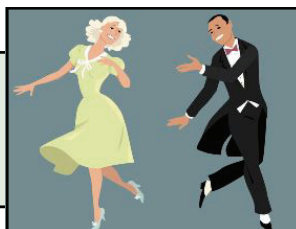
2. **Homework? This is a repeat assignment but, for extra credit, it is worth your time.**
